

PTT Meeting Minutes
November, 14, 2017

Meeting started at 6:04pm at NBA with 18 people present.

Treasurer's report noted that cookie dough had a \$2,800 profit.

Ms. Lanigan had 4 students read to the PTT about putting in a Gaga Ball Pit. They ranged the prices as \$150-\$700. They suggested sand/dirt instead of concrete.
